

Promote local popular science education and encourage students to choose technology-related tertiary education programmes

Encourage students to pursue an I&T career in the future, thus expanding the supply of I&T talent

Funding Scope

- ✓ Hardware
- ✓ Software
- ✓ Cloud Services, etc.

Remarks: IT equipment and related services should not be more than \$500,000 during the entire programme period.





The Requirement of Opening a Bank Account



Requirement

- A designated bank account should be opened for the sole purpose of handling the IT-Lab Programme funding pursuant to ICAC's guideline.
- The bank account opening arrangements : https://www.hkma.gov.hk/eng/smart-consumers/account-opening/contact-details-of-banks/

Exemption Examples

- ✓ Using an existing dormant bank account
- ✓ by stepping up its financial management through a computerised accounting system



Facilitation Measures

Joint Activities Application

- 1. Submit the forms signed by individual principals;
- 2. The joint activities proposal can be prepared and submitted in separate document instead of e-form.

Applicant schools may submit joint applications through e-form submission (the same e-form as the individual application)


Tips and Advice from Vetting Committee



Examples of Applications Not Supported by VC

The expenditure item is not directly related to or essential for implementing the proposed activity

- Upgrade of the whole school network infrastructure
- Setup of a new physical laboratory (e.g. furniture, power socket)



The expenditure item is not costeffective

- Costly equipment (e.g. high cost motion capture system, CAVE system, high cost hologram devices)
- Costly computer servers

The activity is not directly related to the funding scope:

E-learning or life planning management system


